The solar panels at E Berth were replaced at the beginning of FY2020 as committed to in the FY2019 AACR. During the reporting period E Berth availability (87.8 per cent) has improved in comparison to FY2019 (70 per cent). Whilst hard wiring is still being investigated across the network, the source of the non-compliance in the reporting period was driven by unavoidable causes. BHP hope to redefine the term availability to exclude planned maintenance work required to ensure the monitors are aligned with Australian Standard and Manufacturer Requirements alongside any outages due to Cyclone Shutdown Procedures.
